Tips for a Safer Summer!

How is your Summer of Prayer going? Are you finding ways to talk to and also listen to God in your daily life? Summer is a great time to experience and appreciate the beauty God has created all around us. As you are outside enjoying a walk or bike ride or headed to a park or lake, there are so many opportunities to see, smell and hear summer! It's great to be outside in the warm weather, but there are also some things to remember to keep you healthy during the summer heat. Below is a short summer wellness checklist to help you enjoy the season.

- Wear Sunscreen and reapply as needed to avoid sunburn and skin cancer.
- Stay hydrated drinking plenty of water throughout the day, and remember that caffeinated and sugary drinks dehydrate you.
- Eat lighter meals, including lots of fresh fruits and vegetables.
- Learn to swim, wear a lifejacket when using watercraft, and practice safe pool rules.
- Wear a helmet when biking, skateboarding and rollerblading.
- Apply insect repellant to exposed skin and clothing to prevent insect bites and ticks.
- Pay attention to heat advisories and don't over exert yourself on hot days.
- Never leave children or pets in the car unattended.
- Provide shade and plenty of fresh water to pets, and remember that surfaces can burn their paws.
