Gather at Trinity to enjoy some fellowship and a s'more around the campfire. S'mores will be individually packaged for safe distribution.



The monthly column from Trinity's Parish Health Ministry Team



The FDA-approved COVID-19 vaccine is another exciting development that will move us one step closer to our "new normal" during the coronavirus pandemic. Based on the results of our survey, many members at Trinity named vaccine protection as an important criterion for feeling more comfortable with in-person church activities.

The Minnesota Department of Health is coordinating vaccine distribution based on a phased plan and has launched a community COVID-19 Vaccine Pilot Program (https://mn.gov/covid19). The pilot program is open to ANYONE in Minnesota who meets vaccine eligibility. At the time of this update, in addition to healthcare workers, long term care residents and staff, those eligible for the vaccine has expanded to include all Minnesotans >65 years old, educators in pre K-12, school staff and childcare workers.

Doses are quite limited at this time and it is recommended that you check the MDH COVID-19 vaccine website frequently for updates regarding availability and next steps. (https://mn.gov/covid19/vaccine/find-vaccine/index.jsp).

Other options for obtaining the COVID -19 vaccine may be communicated via your primary care, specialty care or VA clinic. Many health systems and clinics have information on their websites regarding COVID-19 vaccination programs and it is recommended that you check back frequently for updates. Some systems have starting making contact with patients via their preferred communication method (mail, phone, email) to share what COVID-19 vaccine information they currently have available to serve both their patients and the community.

Vaccine or no vaccine, we must continue to utilize COVID-19 precautions to minimize community spread:

- · Wear a mask
- Practice social distancing
- Stay outside whenever possible
- Wash your hands
- Stay home when you are sick
- · Get tested if you feel ill
