Trinity will hold its Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 31, at 10:00 am. A Budget Forum Meeting will be held the week before, on Sunday, January 24, at 10:00 am. Each meeting will be held ONLINE through ZOOM — here's how it works:

A hard copy of the Annual Report will be mailed out to every household by the middle of January. This year's Annual Report will not be as detailed as in previous years, but it will include the income/expenses for 2020 as well as a budget for 2021. The list of candidates for the election will also be included. (Passing the budget and electing council and committee members are the two items of business that need to take place at the meeting. A more detailed version of the Annual Report will be available at the church office for those who wish to read it.)

To participate in the meeting, each household will need to have access to a computer, tablet, or phone that is capable of internet access. Before the meeting, a link will be sent to every household through email that will enable us to gather as a congregation. Instructions will be given prior to the meeting on how to participate, including how to vote.

We are clearly aware that holding a meeting over the internet is not the typical way of doing business. But we are convinced that this will be the best way to meet as we continue to move through the COVID-19 crisis. Thank you for your support as we carry on the mission as the Body of Christ!
